Information to be sent before arrival

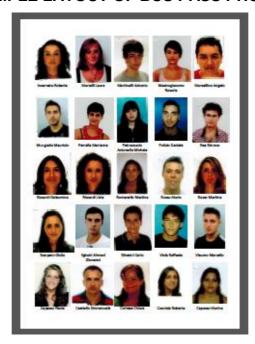
| Full name list of participating students in Excel spread sheet with first name, surname, gender and date of birth, email end telephone number; |

| Colour, passport-style photos of each student <i>and accompanying tutor</i> for whom a bus pass is required. These photos should be compiled by the sending into <u>one single Word Document (or similar)</u> , complete with ALL photos, with the name of each person underneath (see below for example) |
| Full details of arrival and departure of students and tutors (dates, times, flight numbers, airport and terminal number) |
| Completed Medical and Consent Forms for all students (supplied by College) – if students are under 18 these should be completed by parents |
| Completed Rules for all Students on Visits Forms for all students (supplied by College) |
| Completed Parental Consent Forms for all under-18-year-old students (supplied by College) |
| All students should be tested with the Cambridge Online Test - http://www.cambridgeesol.org/test-your-english/index.php/ and a list of students with their test score should be provided |
| Completed Parental Consent Forms Placement in case of work placement (supplied by College). |

Preparation Lessons for Students before arrival in the UK

- All students should watch these 2 videos:
 - The Untold Story a video about the College's history <u>http://www.bournville.ac.uk/the-college/history/</u>
 - College Rules a video about expected behaviour from all students http://vimeo.com/38080630
 - Class discussion should take place after the videos have been shown to test the students' understanding of the content. The expected behaviour standards should also be reinforced by the tutors.
 - This activity should take a maximum of 1 hour.
- Using www.travelwestmidlands.co.uk, the tutor should show students how to use Birmingham public transport. The students can explore different options for travelling around the city.
- Using http://visitbirmingham.com/, the tutor should spend 1-2 hours showing students
 Birmingham's attractions. The students can then shortlist places they would like to visit
 during their stay.
